Helping staff to help young people

More than 70 virtual schools are now using *MyLibrary* to help their looked after children. In 2017, we're excited about using the same mobile learning technology to train staff as well.

Our *CPD Library* provides a growing range of reference material and training courses for adults who work with children and young people. Topics covered at the moment include attachment, pastoral issues, radicalisation, responsibilities of designated teachers, information handling and many more.

In many ways, using mobile learning resources with staff is more straightforward than it is with children and young people. Most staff already have a smartphone or tablet and the web version is available for those who do not.

We offer two versions of the *CPD Library* for virtual schools:

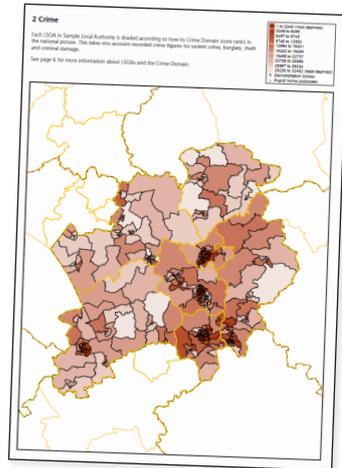

Looking at deprivation data

We are always looking for new ways to help virtual schools and deepen our relationship with them. One way we have been doing this recently is by helping them to get an insight into the issues affecting their looked after children by using deprivation data.

National data is available on a variety of forms of deprivation, including crime, low income, barriers to housing and services, and education. Drawing on this, we are able to produce maps and data tables that give a very detailed picture of the specific issues affecting local areas.



The more you know about the nature of the communities in which your looked after children live, the better placed you are to support them. Our **Confidential Reports – Community Issues** service can help you to:

- › plan interventions
- › contribute to PEPs
- › answer questions from elected members and senior managers
- › justify placement changes
- › explain issues to Ofsted inspectors
- › argue for changes to placement policy.
